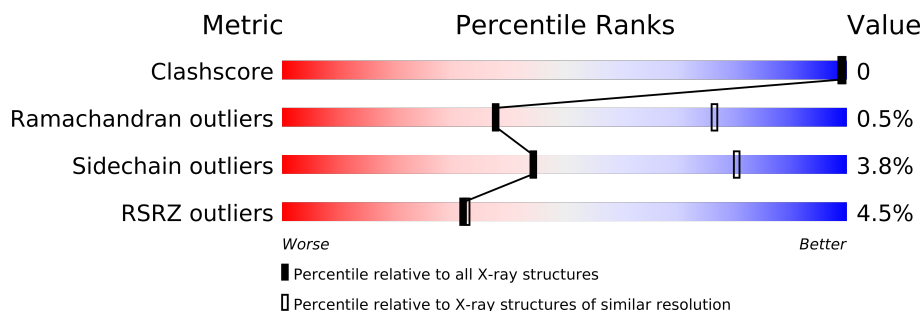

1 Overall quality at a glance

The reported resolution of this entry is 2.80 Å.

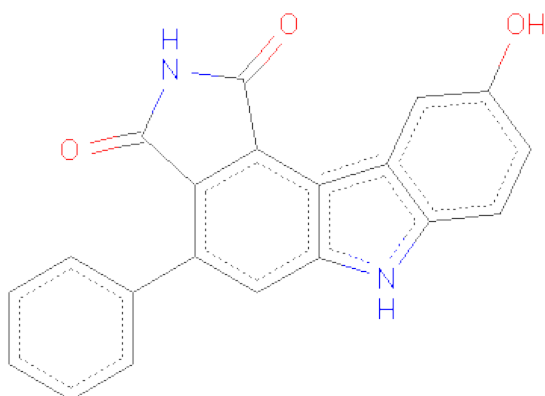

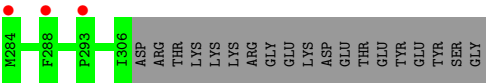

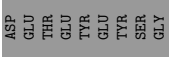

5.2 Close contacts
